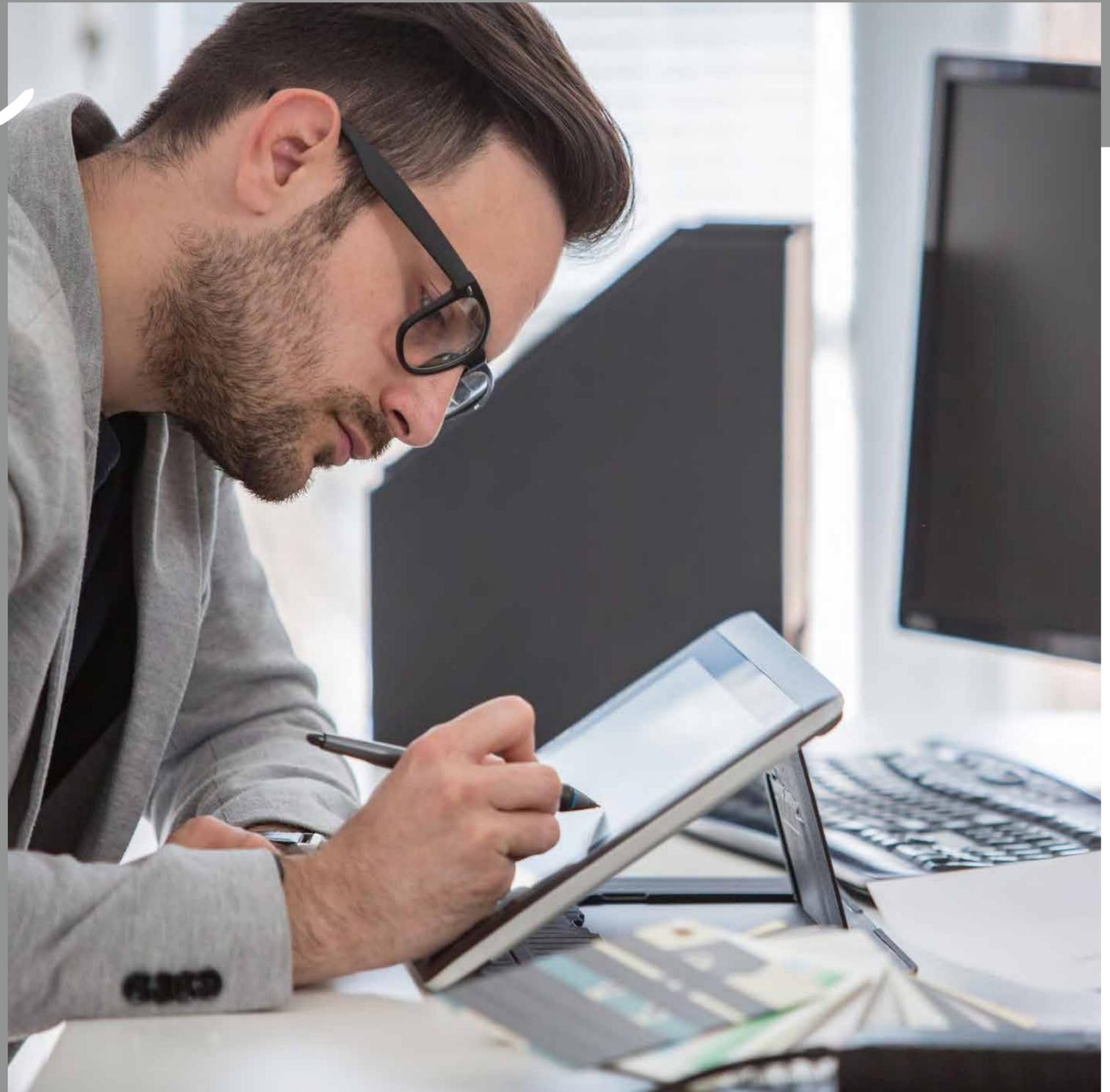

Simple remote productivity

Every office contains a myriad of digital devices, such as iPads, tablets or laptops, for ideating, creating documents, designing plans, engaging with co-workers, running meetings or providing feedback. But if these devices leave the office, they put a heavy burden on IT staff, especially in terms of updates and security. Purpose-built, software neutral devices enhance employee productivity without adding IT workload.



WHY PURPOSE-BUILT IS BETTER

Using a purpose-built interactive pen display from Wacom (such as the 16-inch DTH-1660E Interactive Pen Display) opens up previously untapped opportunities for remote workers. It's designed for heavy duty usage with a durable physical design and a full 5-year extended warranty. And, unlike most devices designed for remote working, which require the use of proprietary software, all Wacom pen displays are software neutral. That means every business can utilize its standard software programs, such as Microsoft PowerPoint or whiteboard and collaboration cloud applications like Miro. This makes them easy to integrate into the existing IT infrastructure, and simple for managers and employees to start using with the digital pen that comes with the display.

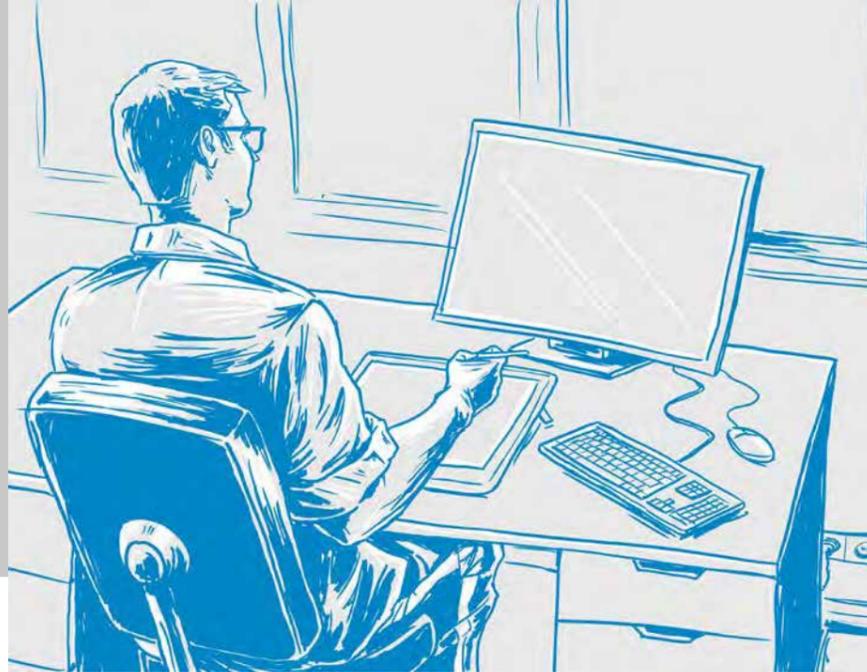
RICH CONTENT, DELIVERED REMOTELY

Remote workers can use Wacom pen displays to bridge the distance between themselves and team members dispersed around the world. These devices enable managers to create rich, interactive collaboration and meeting experiences that invite participants to get involved, just as they would in person.

For example, whether starting with a blank slate or marking-up existing presentations, managers can run meetings while simultaneously engaging attendees with handwritten notes and pictures. If team members also have a pen-enabled device, such as the compact and affordable Wacom One, they can also respond with handwritten inputs.

LEGALLY BINDING REMOTE DIGITAL SIGNATURES

In addition, managers can sign off on documents digitally with their handwritten signature, just as they would on paper. No printing, scanning, sending or archiving required. And because all the pen inputs are digitally-rendered, the most up-to-date versions of all documents can be stored and distributed electronically and immediately, anytime.

IDEATION & MEETING PREPARATION

1 Managers can use a pen display such as the Wacom DTK-1660E to generate better ideas as they annotate, sketch, highlight and explain content within the material before they present it. As a result, static concepts and meeting plans become dynamic, interactive presentations and brainstorming sessions.

ONLINE MEETINGS & BRAINSTORMING

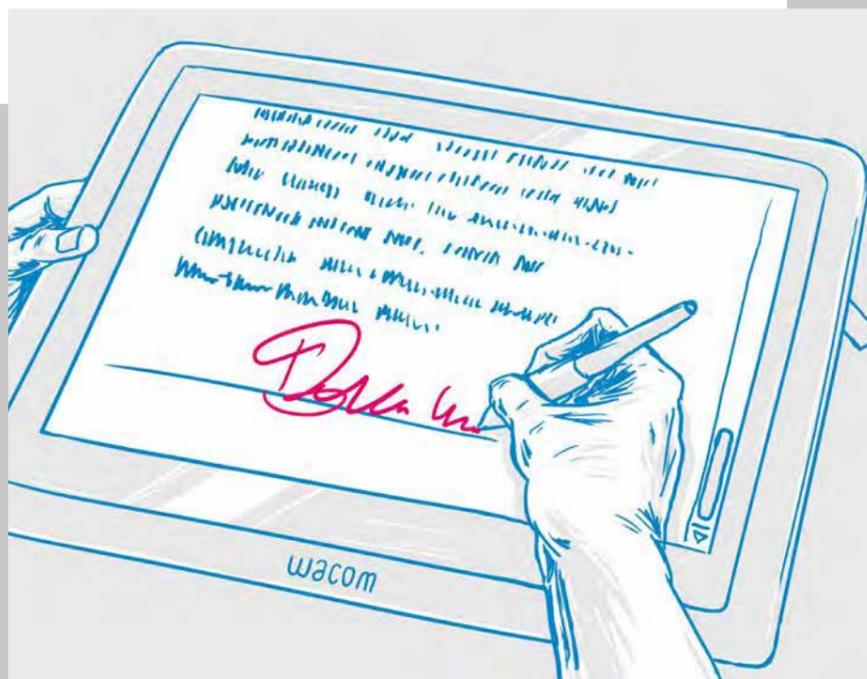
2 During the meeting, managers can use the pen display to mark up and annotate their pre-prepared digital content. This could mean, for example, capturing employee comments and elaborating on key concepts with drawings, sketches and diagrams, or adding new

information on the fly. And, in freestyle brainstorming meetings that don't use as many prepared materials, the manager can use the digital pen with whiteboard software to write and sketch just as they would in a physical meeting room.

DOCUMENT SIGNING

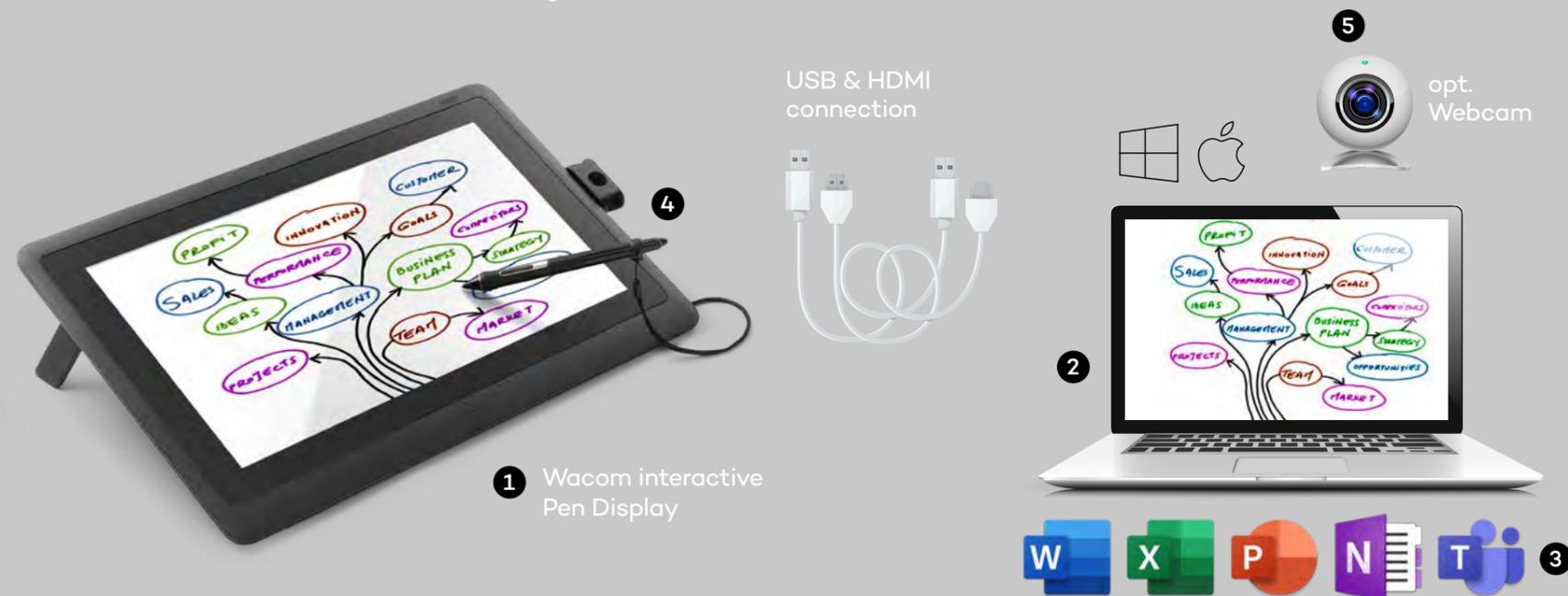
3 Using a pen-enabled device such as a Wacom pen display, Lenovo Yoga Book or Microsoft Surface together with Wacom sign pro PDF software, managers can sign off on important decisions and contracts digitally,

just as they would on paper. This removes the logjam in the remote working process caused by having to print, sign and send or scan physical documents.

PRESENT AND COLLABORATE INTERACTIVELY

- The Wacom interactive pen display **1** is connected directly to the remote worker's computer **2**. This means he or she can work with their familiar applications and services **3**.
- The remote worker can use the battery-free and pressure-sensitive digital pen to ideate, make notes and sketch naturally and directly on the display in applications like Microsoft Word, Power Point, Excel, or OneNote. They can also save the completed file in multiple formats such as PDF, JPEG, GIF, PNG, etc **3**.
- Managers can run interactive meetings, present content spontaneously and use the familiar, intuitive digital pen **4** to annotate as they collaborate via drawings, comments and notes.
- Depending on their hardware and software setup, managers can also use a web cam **5** for enhanced engagement with employees.
- Ideally, employees would also have access to a pen-enabled device, so that they can participate in the meeting using handwritten inputs too.
- During or after the meeting, the manager can add action points and store or distribute the documents electronically, easily and quickly

- sign pro PDF software **1** is the easiest way to add handwritten electronic signatures to documents when working from home.
- Simply connect your Windows PC **2** via a USB connector **3** to 4. a Wacom signature pad **4** or pen display and use the digital pen to sign as you would on paper - no scanning, printing, sending or archiving required!



sign pro PDF can also be used to add signatures to documents using iPads, Android tablets and Windows devices such as the Lenovo Yoga Book or Microsoft Surface.

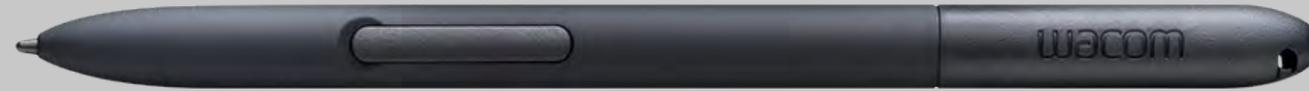
